Dear Parents/Carers

On Monday 12<sup>th</sup> of October 2020 all Catholic College Sale students will return to onsite learning. It will be wonderful to see the College come to life again and we cannot wait to see all our students.

With the return to onsite learning there are a number of protocols set by external Governing bodies that we are required to follow:

- Students are required to continue to wear fitted face masks (unless medically exempt)
- Maintain social distancing when outside of a classroom setting
- The College is required to take students temperatures prior to entering the College. Staff will be available from 8.15am at the entrance gates to support a seamless start to the school day.

St. Patrick's campus entrance and temperature check points - Macalister Street entrances (x 2), Reeve Street entrance, Desailly Street entrance. (Cunningham Street entrance near the cinema will remain closed).

Sion campus entrance and temperature check points – Raymond Street entrance, Raglan Street bus entrance.

Any late arrivals must immediately attend student services, which is on the St. Patrick's campus and is temporarily being operated from the Library due to works on the Allman Building.

On their return, students are required to wear full summer uniform. New summer uniforms can be purchased through our stockists, David's Menswear in Raymond Street.
